Dear Mr. Dominiak

I received and reviewed the test results on the waste fuel to be used at the New Windsor Facility. In addition, I reviewed the final stack test report for the combustion efficiency test conducted on the TPS Technologies Soil Remediation Unit (SRU) at the New Windsor facility while it was firing Waste Fuel A.

From the supplied test information on the waste fuel by Connecticut Waste Oil Inc., the product in which they are supplying to your facility meets the requirement of 6NYCRR 225-2 for Waste Fuel A. TPS may continue to use the fuel supplied from this company as long as it continues to meet the requirements in 6NYCRR 225-2. Records must be kept on the fuel usage as well as the fuel composition reports from the fuel supplier.

The Department requires a combustion efficiency of 99% while firing Waste Fuel A to comply with 6NYCRR 225-2. The combustion stack test completed on May 17, 2000, on the SRU was greater than 99% on each of the three test runs, with an average efficiency of 99.989%.

With these results, SRU at the New Windsor Facility, meets the requirements of 6NYCRR 225-2 and may continue to use waste fuel as the primary fuel.
